MODULES OFFERED:

Choose one module from the following that will be offered to the first 10 respondents per module (studying is done in a small, interactive groups). First come, first serve! Modules are co-led by experienced facilitators. For all modules, **35-40** hours of advance homework is required and is sent ahead of the course session. **To satisfactorily pass our modules, you must complete a minimum of 80% of these assignments prior to coming and attend at least 80% of the sessions. You will be asked to report the percentage of assignments you have completed at the training.**

The following order is recommended:

Facilitating Relational Learning (FRL)

This module explores the unique needs of the adult learner and studies the teaching methods of Jesus to determine why he is so effective in promoting change and maturity in others. Participants experience how facilitating discussions in a relational context is a powerful way to not only introduce content but to also stimulate growth that leads to mature disciples of Jesus Christ. Through developing significant, open questions and using the best educational practices for adults, participants learn and practice how to facilitate transformational, biblically-based discussions while receiving meaningful feedback from others. (Practice text: *Walking with Christ*, Required Foundational Module.)

Developing a Discerning Heart (DDH)

This module investigates God's design of men and women as image-bearers of God and the farreaching effects of the Fall upon that image. It studies the life-changing impact of Christ's redemption and its effects not only on one's thirst for God but also on each person's mind, will, and emotions. Participants will look at their identity in Christ and see how God has been intricately at work in the story of their lives. Through understanding God's transforming power in their lives, participants are better equipped to come alongside others to help and encourage them in their walk with God. (Prerequisite: FRL)

Discovery Bible Study (DBS)

This module focuses on how to effectively study the Bible to enrich devotional times, lead small group discussions, and prepare lessons and messages. Participants work systematically through the process of observation, interpretation, and application of biblical passages to understand the author's original intent and accurately apply the Word of God. Participants also prepare and

facilitate a topical study, a small group Bible study, and a short message based on a passage of Scripture as well as receive feedback for continued growth in their facilitation skills. (Prerequisite: FRL, DDH)

TO REGISTER:

Registration deadline is: February 13, 2021

Cost: \$400.00 or 40,000 Kenya Shillings

This price includes food and lodging for the duration of your stay plus transport to and from Nairobi. You will be sharing your room with others.

If you would like to pay for a private double room, the cost is \$560.00 or 56,000 Kenya Shillings.

If you are able to pay online with a credit card please pay the full amount when you register. If you are not able to pay on-line with a credit card, then payment is due upon arrival, on the first day of the training. Here is the website you can go to pay online. (www.entrust4.org/orders).

When the module is confirmed, you will be able to order your workbooks at www.entrust4.org/orders and begin your advance coursework. Do not order your workbooks ahead of time; there are no refunds for workbooks. Costs for digital workbooks are \$25. The Developing a Discerning Heart has one workbook, and FRL has two: Walking with Christ and Facilitator Training.

**Limited scholarship funds are available for no more than half of the cost of the training. If you would like to apply for assistance, please let me know and I will send you the necessary forms to complete.

TRANSPORTATION:

For those flying into Nairobi, you will need to make arrangements to arrive at the Nairobi airport no later than 2:00 Saturday afternoon, June 5th, and leaving no sooner than Saturday evening, June 12th. We will make arrangements to meet you at the airport and take you to Brackenhurst.

For those living in Kenya, arrangements will be made for you to travel by taxi together from Nairobi to Brackenhurst Saturday afternoon.
