Refugee ministry intern

Summary: Provides spiritual, emotional, vocational and life skills support to Arabic-speaking refugee or Arabic background women and families living in southern Europe Ministry conducted through the Center of Orality, where oral biblical storytelling is modeled and taught.

SPECIFIC AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- Assist Arabic-background female refugees, immigrants and residents in learning vocational, emotional and coping skills related to cultural adjustments.
- Tutor and assist Arabic-speaking children in the local language.
- Tutor and assist Arabic-speaking children to read and write the Arabic language.
- Offer biblical storytelling and initiate spiritual conversations with refugee women and children.
- Offer spiritual support and direction to other members of refugee families, as appropriate.
- Recruit and mobilize new staff, interns and donors to Entrust.
- Assist program lead as needed.

OUTCOMES

- Intern will develop functional literacy in the local language.
- Intern will gain experience in assisting Arabic people who are transitioning to a new culture.
- Intern will be trained and become experienced in oral biblical storytelling.
- Intern will gain understanding of local cultures and religions.
- Intern will gain experience in cross-cultural ministry and in sharing the gospel across language barriers.
- Intern will explore and grow in understanding of giftedness and calling from God.
- Refugee women, youth and their families will experience meaningful, biblical guidance and discussion.
- Local churches will be better equipped to serve refugees.
- Entrust will have an increased impact with refugees in the region, through encouragement, oral biblical storytelling and spiritual discussions with refugees.
