- Research and identify strategic additions to Entrust training and equipping programs for men, working closely with Entrust's international leaders and curriculum department.
- Assist with training/facilitating, coordination and any other needs of the Entrust hubs in the U.S. and overseas.
- Promote and lead Entrust ministry and curriculum in home church.
- Go on international trips up to two per year.
- Support varied Entrust projects as needed.
