



## Women-to-Women Ministry Training

#### Modules Offered

##### Facilitating Relational Learning

This module explores the unique needs of the adult learner and how facilitating discussions in a relational context can be a powerful way to not only discuss content but stimulate growth that leads to mature disciples of Jesus Christ. Each participant facilitates multiple discussions for hands-on experience and receives meaningful evaluation from their peers.

The two workbooks required are: *Facilitator Training* and *Walking with Christ*.

##### Developing a Discerning Heart

The DDH module explores God's design of men and women as image-bearers of God and the far-reaching effects of the Fall. It studies the life-changing impact of Christ's redemption and its effects not only on man's thirst for God but also on each person's mind, will, and emotions. It looks at the new identity we have in Christ and how that enables us to live redeemed lives and, in turn, help others in their own growth process. *Pre-requisite: Facilitating Relational Learning*

*Workbook required: Developing a Discerning Heart*

#### Registration Information

##### Space is Limited

Learning takes place in small groups and is limited to **8-10** participants, to enhance relational learning and allow for maximum interaction. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Therefore, we suggest you complete the registration process as soon as possible to secure your place. Registration will close **October 6, 2019**.

##### Pastoral Support

Your pastor or ministry leader's support is required at the time of registration. If your pastor or ministry leader is not aware of your interest in participating in this training, please communicate this with him/her and confirm his/her support of this endeavor for you. Once you've received confirmation, you may continue with the registration process. Please contact your hub coordinator if your pastor or ministry leader would like additional information about WWMT's 4 core modules.

If you are in a mission or parachurch organization and not a home church situation, then substitute your organization's information, your direct supervisor's name and their approval for you to take this training.

### **Registration Fees & Refund Policy**

The registration fee is **\$150** and due at the time of registration. This price includes your materials and lunches. After you have completed the online registration, go to BCC PAYMENT to pay your registration fee.

If you need to cancel and do so on **October 18, 2019**, you will be refunded 80% of the registration to cover administration fees. Please email the site coordinator ([hannahh@entrust4.org](mailto:hannahh@entrust4.org)) if you need to cancel. Cancellation on or after **October 19, 2019** will result in forfeiting the entire cost of \$150.

### **Materials**

Materials will be mailed to you once your registration is completed and the module is confirmed on or before October 6. All modules require **30-40** hours of advanced prep work which is essential to the interactive and relational learning experience. We ask that you please allow for this time in your schedule.

### **Transportation & Guest Housing**

We have several families who live close to Burke Community Church who are offering a guest room for participants and facilitators to save on hotel fees. If you would like to request guest housing you will have the opportunity to do so when you complete your BCC PAYMENT form.

If you are traveling via air or train, **please wait to make your travel plans and until the module is confirmed.** If for any reason the module needs to be cancelled, we don't want you left with a non-refundable ticket.

**Arrival time:** Make arrangements to arrive in Burke, VA, by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Jan 22, 2020. We will have a welcome dinner on Wednesday, Jan 22 @ 7pm at a home near the church. You might plan to arrive on the early side to avoid a negative traffic experience! If you are unable to attend the dinner, the training will begin at 8:00am on Thursday, Jan 23 at Burke Community Church.

**Departure time:** We will end Saturday, Jan 25, by 5 p.m. or before. Lunch is provided. Flight or train travel should be made after 7:30 p.m. Late arrivals and/or early departures from the training are discouraged as attendance at 80% of sessions is required to successfully complete the module and have the ability to order materials in the future.
